



Freestyle Whistler: Communicable Disease Plan

Updated Oct 19, 2021

Freestyle Whistler Board of Directors continues to review and update the Club's COVID-19 policies and Communicable Disease Plan as directed by the Provincial Health Office and ViaSport. These policies are of utmost importance with the case counts of COVID in BC and the particularly contagious and virulent variants.

The policies below are consistent with the BC PHO and the requirements and recommendations from ViaSport, Freestyle BC, WorkSafeBC and Whistler Blackcomb. As of this date, proof of vaccination is **not** required to participate in any organization outdoor sport in BC.

All members, staff and volunteers must follow the policies of Whistler Blackcomb when on their properties.

1. Outdoor Activities

All athletes may participate in outdoor freestyle ski training, dryland training activities, subject to the remainder of this policy.

2. Daily Health Checks

Daily Health Attestations will be sent via email on every scheduled day of training to participants. All staff and athletes must fill out this form before attending the training session. No athlete is to attend training if they or any family member is experiencing COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms.

3. Masks

In keeping in line with the current [PHO order](#), masks must be worn by all athletes, staff, and volunteers:

- in **any outdoor** area where physical distancing of 2m is not possible; and
- in **all indoor areas** of FW facilities by everyone over the age of 5 years old.

4. FW Clubhouse & Judges Stand

All those entering the Clubhouse are required to wear a face covering. No congregating will be permitted in that area. All athletes are expected to only transit through the Clubhouse to store or obtain their bag, equipment or clothing. Only coaches/staff are allowed in the Coaches' Room.

The Judges Stand is to be used as a warming hut during the 2021/2022 Ski Season. A face covering is required unless actively eating or drinking.

5. Travel

All athletes can attend Timber Tour and Canada Cup events, subject to any requirements set by host ski hills, ski clubs, Freestyle BC, Freestyle Canada. Athletes who wish to travel and live communally in a team house, all eligible athletes and chaperones must be fully vaccinated.

6. Staff & Coaches

Freestyle Whistler will require that all coaches and staff be fully vaccinated.

7. Events

All events will be conducted per current PHO Orders and will have their safety plans. Participants will be expected to adhere to the event safety plan.
